

Discovery Education: Accessing Digital Educational Videos for the Classroom

Use these video to facilitate student learning in all content areas, such as Language Arts, Social Studies, Math, Science, Physical Education, Visual and Performing Arts, World Languages, etc. Most video also include teacher guides to facilitate not only the video but the whole curriculum as well. Video quizzes follow most videos, creating an engaging and accurate way to assess and reinforce student learning.

1. Type www.discoveryeducation.com in your web browser and press *Enter*.
2. Contact System Administrator for Login Information. Log in.
3. Enter a topic in the *Search* bar (for example World War One).
4. Choose a video—with cursor, hover over options for further details, such as a description, grade level, teacher guide availability, curriculum standards, and even a brief clip. Click on chosen video.
5. Click on large video still on left side of screen to play video or click on specific segments on right side to view segments.
6. Click *Full Screen* icon on bottom of screen for full screen viewing. Press *Escape* to exit full screen mode.
7. Store entire video and/or segments for easy future access by selecting box next to full video or segments on right side of screen.
8. Make sure *My Content* is selected in box below. Click *Add*.
9. Now you can find that video easily by clicking *My Content* any time while logged in, selecting the desired video, and pressing *Play*.
